



#### 1) We Want to Hear From You! Vote on Two Resolutions at the Annual General Meeting (preceding the Chapter BBQ) on June 11!

As announced on April 8, the Greater Toronto Chapter Board voted unanimously in favour of joining CaGBC and other Chapters to become part of one integrated nationwide organization. We strongly support this new integrated model, which will now be brought to our members for a vote of approval at the Annual General Meeting (AGM) on June 11. We believe the integrated model will better engage and service our GTA stakeholders, Chapter members, and the Canadian green building industry at large. It will also better equip our Chapter to represent regional interests at the national level. ## 4) Greenest School Competition

The Canada Green Building Council and the Canada Coalition for Green Schools are searching for the 2015 Greenest School in Canada. This is a school at the elementary or secondary level that truly exemplifies how sustainability can be integrally woven into the infrastructure, culture and curriculum. The Greenest School in Canada wins: \$2,000 in prize money to use for a green activity and the coveted title of Greenest School in Canada; and is submitted as the official Canadian entry into the Greenest School on Earth competition, awarded annually by the Center for Green Schools. ## 5) Submissions Now Open for the 2015 CaGBC-GTC's Innovation in LEED Awards

Projects and individuals that demonstrate advancement in the green building industry in Southern Ontario will be recognized at the Chapter's annual CaGBC Greater Toronto Chapter Gala and Aw ards evening. Four Innovation in LEED Aw ards and the Innovation in Sustainability Aw ard will be selected by our panel of experts. A separate panel will evaluate the individual and enviroSCULPT aw ards. The 8 aw ards will include: Innovation in LEED Aw ard (New Construction/Core and Shell); Innovation in LEED Aw ard (Commercial Interiors); Innovation in LEED Aw ard (EB:O&M); Innovation in LEED Aw ard (Residential); Innovation in Sustainability Aw ard (projects, programs or policies that are exceptionally innovative, but not necessarily tied to LEED); Greater Toronto Chapter (GTC) Volunteer Aw ard; Greater Toronto Chapter (GTC) Leader Aw ard; and the Emerging Green Builder (EGB) enviroSCULPT Aw ard. Please take note of the following important dates: deadline for submissions is August 14, 2015 for the Innovation in LEED Aw ards, Innovation in Sustainability Aw ard and the Individual Aw ards and September 24, 2015 for the enviroSCULPT Aw ard. Finalists for all aw ards (with the exception of the enviroSCULPT Aw ard) will be announced on September 18, 2015. ## 6) New Water Conservation Pilot Project in York Region

Mozaik Homes, a brand new housing development of 185 homes, is participating in a water conservation pilot project as requested by the Region of York. With the goal of combining water and energy conservation initiatives, Mozaik Homes decided to use the Savings by Design program to accomplish this target. The development, located at the southeast corner of Davis Drive and Bathurst Street, is anticipated to achieve 28%

energy savings based on the model that was created in collaboration with the Savings by Design program. A conservation program offered by Enbridge Gas Distribution to residential and commercial builders, Savings by Design assists in obtaining higher levels of energy and environmental performance through the application of the Integrated Design Process (IDP). The objective of the program is to achieve a 25% efficiency over the current building code through alternative design approaches. Based on the model, facilitated by Sustainable Buildings Canada, builders and developers participate in an IDP workshop allowing builders and their tradespeople to realize the potential for achieving higher levels of energy and environmental performance.
