Emerging Trends:

- *LTC is struggling to meet current requirements; 99% of LTC beds are occupied, 20,000 waiting list .
 - *Cost of Care is unstainable in it's current form \$1.3 Trillion required over the next 15 years. \$590 Billion in the budget. Health care costs could be \$54,000 per person in Ontario in 15 years!

TRENDS/ REALITIES

- 10 years ago -2.5 million family caregivers, today: 8.5 million and another 2 million next year.
- Cost of Care: \$ Hospital Bed -\$842

\$ LTC Bed -\$440

\$ Home Care -\$242

TRENDS/REALTIES

- Convergence of aging and technology
- Convergence of aging and financial issues
- Big Data --building trust—powerful but also a huge liability
- Private/Public Partnerships Cross sector partnerships
- Improved research
- Older work force

TRENDS/ REALITIES

- Cultural shifts that are taking place in public sector -benefits can be enormous if we strike the right balance.
- The increase in loneliness in the older adults, particularly the frail elderly some living the winter without going outside.
- The increase in senior adult fraud inside and outside the family.

TRENDS/REALITIES

- Retirement challenges nobody knows what their retirement liability is---its like having a house and not knowing your mortgage.
- Need to support family caregivers local caregiver support programs led by municipality – not just seniors groups – harness the boomer power locally
